Wisconsin Remains No.1 in College Ultimate Open Rankings

BOULDER, Colo. – Wisconsin remains the top ranked team in College Open Ultimate according to the Ultimate Players Association (UPA) College Ultimate Open rankings. The Hodags went undefeated during Centex and recorded impressive wins over Texas, Colorado and Stanford – all top 10 teams.

Although no teams dropped out of the Top 25 from a week ago, there were many changes to the order of the teams. Stanford finished second to Wisconsin at Centex and propelled ahead from No.5 to No.2. Carleton College moved up the most spots with a win over then No.2 Florida in the quarterfinals of Centex.

Wisconsin's reign over the rankings this season is similar to that of Florida a year ago. Florida held the top spot wire-to-wire and finished the season with a win over Wisconsin in the UPA College Championship final.
