## **Open College Ultimate Rankings Remain Mostly Unchanged Wisconsin Remains No.1 for Sixth-Straight Week**

BOULDER, Colo. – There wasn't much movement this week in the Ultimate Players Association (UPA) Open College Ultimate rankings. In fact, there were no changes to the top 10 as teams remained idle, resting up for this weekend's sectionals.

Wisconsin, runner-up to Florida in last year's UPA College Championships, held onto the top spot for the sixth week in a row, followed by Stanford and Florida. All three are separated less than 60 points.

Brown moved up four spots to No.16 with a fine showing at the Yale Cup. They went undefeated during pool play before losing to Harvard in the semifinals.

The big movers of the week were Dartmouth who moved up 10 spots to replace James Madison at No.25. Dartmouth also competed in the Yale Cup, finishing second to Harvard.

This weekend marks the second of three-straight weekends of Sectional competition across the country. It is the first step for teams hoping to qualify for the 2007 UPA College Ultimate Championships held May 25-27 in Columbus, Ohio.
